Ad dressed other track concerns and registration questions.

Chief Instructors, Jim Briggs and Jerry Wolf: Jim not present, Jerry reported on the DE Committee Meeting. We are doing as close as we can to running good, efficient, safe events. Some new ideas to implement: instructor feedback, student feedback with questionnaires and advancing the marketing of the events. Two other issues the committee wanted addressed: 1) the Taste of the Track has been so successful and we have had an increase in very new drivers who need to borrow their first use helmets that we recommend a purchase of six new helmets. 2) National is allowing the use of motorcycle helmets, but are keeping SA recommendations for Club Racing. They recommend replacing helmets after 5 years due to deterioration of interiors, etc. New helmets in 2010 will mean that we will drop the 2000 helmets. A flat ruling will eliminate having to police helmets at tech inspection.

Concours, John Meyer: not present. Ted reminded everyone about the Ault Park Concours coming up this weekend.

Club Race, Rich Rosenberg and Larry Lindgren: report that there are 2/3rd the racers and 1/2 DE numbers. Solo and Intermediate can run this event without instructors. An email blast was sent about the change of pricing on the DE.
