

MINUTES OF MEETING OF OVR/PCA SEPTEMBER 8, 2009  
AT UNO'S IN WEST CHESTER, OHIO

Meeting called to order at 7:07 p.m. Motion to approve minutes of previous meeting made by Kathie Hunter, seconded by Charlene Naber. Motion approved. Carston welcomed Jeff and Reba McGurk, new members who will be at Mid Ohio.

President's report, Carston Naber: Carson met with Porsche of the Village re: Palooza. John Meyer said there will be a display of cars in front of dealership for Palooza, one of each kind. He will send out an email so people can sign up.

Vice President, Jerry Babic: Not here. Carston reported on Jerry's new job, Escape insurance etc.

Secretary, Jill Buzzard: Nothing to report

Treasurer's report, Mary Louise Bauman: Not present. Larry Lindgren gave her report; Checking account balance is \$25,730. Money market balance is \$38,693. Races are in the black by \$10,000. Repaid all who cancelled Bluegrass. We need about \$13,000 to break even at Autumn Thunder. We will have about \$2,000 to spend on Palooza and \$4,000 for charities.

Advertising, Charlene: No report. She is still collecting.

Autocross, Terry Weiss is not here.

Autumn Thunder at Mid Ohio: Gary says we are in desperate need of students, nowhere near breaking even yet. As of right now he is not ordering merchandizing. Encourage people to encourage drivers for Mid Ohio. Kathie said Mid Ohio region has canceled their event at Bluegrass.

Chief Instructors, Jerry Wolf/Jim Briggs: Jim said we have 94 people signed up for Mid Ohio. (Herb Beck checked website and there are currently 96 signed up)

Concours, John Meyer: VW Porsche reunion 27 Sept. Escape concours; we will talk about later.

Historian, Dick Weiss: Not here.

Club Race, Rich Rosenberg. We did very well, made over \$10,000 profit. Rich would like to buy a set of scales, to be available to anyone who needs them. They cost from \$1200 to \$3500.

IRAC, Open chair.

Members at large; Dennis Okin, not here. Bill Kief: Plenty of hotel rooms available at mid Ohio. Bill wants to eblast other clubs. Kathie said go to the national website for info. Jonathan Winterkorn, not present.

Old business:

Escape, Walter Chin: Committee meeting last week with Roy Wilkinson, zone rep, present. We are opening it up to local OVR members. Roy will be assisting with contacting other clubs in region. Vu Nuygen, PCA executive director, announced MOBIL1 will give us \$5,000. Bose is contributing \$2500 in merchandise for prizes. Kathie said White Allen will be unveiling the Panamera at the Thursday night event. People will have to pre-register for this event. We are opening other events for local members also. At Shine and Show there will be a flyover of the Wright B flyer.

Membership, Dale Timmester: 6 new members, total of 658 primary and 525 affiliates.

Newsletter, Kathie Hunter: Turning it over to the printer the morning of the 15<sup>th</sup>. No one has offered to take over newsletter.

Dave Raum suggested, since the newsletter is an important part of the Club, that in light of Kathie giving up the newsletter, if we can't get anybody to take over, as an alternative we could have John Wahle and Don Winder work up something in a template form on the website, so that when Gary Nichols does Mid Ohio, for example, he can go out and put in DE info, etc. There could be a President's page and a calendar. It could be a self-sustaining newsletter with an overseer.

We should have a meeting with John and Don.

Jim Biggs suggested scare tactics, as in putting in the newsletter, with countdown times, "this is or will be the last newsletter." Kathie said she can do that.

Public relations, Christine Pugh. Not here.

Safety, Dan Jauch. Not present.

Technical, Rich Rosenberg: No report.

Webmaster, John Wahle: Not here. Everything is up to date as of last Friday.

Dan Jauch is preparing nominating committee for next year.

New business. Charlene is arranging Palooza. Kathie asked why we are not charging nominal fee for Palooza. She thinks we should, maybe \$10 a head. Cash bar suggested; that would entail a bartender.
