My son is focused, dare I say, obsessed. He's been talking about this car for months. He's got spy photos and leaks from Toyota GR have been compiled. The car in question is a 2023 Toyota GR86. The spec and the color are unobtainium. Neptune Blue, 6 speed, Alcantara interior, GR is for Gazoo Racing, it's not a timid car.

There was one in the US, close to what he wanted, but was spoken for and he was in no mood to settle. He reluctantly went to a local dealer, specced the car the way he wanted, laid down his deposit and hoped for the best. He was told it could be 6 months maybe, which then passed, now it could be a year. Like all of us do, he was scanning BaT and other sites hoping he could find her, then she appeared in Alabama. The dealer wasn't sure how they got her but the car was to be delivered the next day. A flurry of calls, then wiring money, then the call to the old man.

"Hey Dad, I found my car, want to go to Alabama?" "Yes. Yes I do"

Coming up on Valentine's Day the temps are in the mid to high 40s but the night temps are in the 20s. I've been itching like a guy coming off meth to get one of my cars out and this seemed like a great opportunity. See below as to why that didn't happen.

The morning we left it was 29 degrees in Cincinnati and I was looking forward to crossing into Tennessee where we knew it was sunny and warm. Nothing like a road trip with someone who is so amped to see his car that he hasn't slept well in 3 days. We arrived in Albertville, Alabama early afternoon and the dealer had the car out front. Matt's jaw dropped to the floor and I was taken aback at how violent the car looked. Paperwork done, they handed Matt the keys and we decided to take the car out around the lake resort area surrounding Albertville; a stunning area by the way, highly recommend a visit. After a spell we made our way north to Spring Hill, Tennessee.

Not what you think they are... Both of my cars have Michelin Pilot Sport 4S. I know they're summer tires but have never gotten a straight answer regarding the temperature necessary for the tires to work optimally. I'd been led to believe 45 degrees minimum. I went back to the guy who sold and installed the tires, they weren't sure and called the local Michelin rep. The answers he gave were Jeff close but not convincing. I reached out to Michelin and they responded fast.

From Michelin: "The Pilot Sport 4S is classified as an ultra high performance (UHP) summer tire. Michelin UHP uses tread compounds that are optimized for maximum dry and damp grip in temperate conditions. As the temp of the compound nears freezing, the grip level of the tire begins to degrade. Michelin does not recommend using the UHP Sport summer tires when the temps drop below 40 degrees." The letter went on to explain in excruciating detail what happens as the temp falls. Based on this I wasn't driving a Porsche.

The point of this is the tires on your car may not be what you think they are and if you have questions you really should reach out to the manufacturer to get the facts. (www.michelinman.com)

We are a conservative club and risk aversion is important. We bought the CD's before interest rates started rising and they will mature at full face value and will not impact us. We are bidding out the paper for Panorama. It is expensive but the PCA believes they have a resolution. PCA had an overall 6.04% growth in membership. This is the largest December growth since 2012 (477). New members joined is at 1,176, the best since 2014; late renewals best since 2015 (800). The PCA is growing in leaps and bounds. We are gearing up for the Porsche 75th anniversary celebration this year. On March 27th, 2023 there is a meeting of all Club Presidents worldwide. President Clark will be attending with Vice-President Nucete. May 10th, 2023 is the 75th birthday of Wolfgang Porsche. We are doing a Cars and Coffee event that weekend, May 13th, 2023, at Garage Living in Blue Ash. If you have any ideas or suggestions for the Dr. Porsche birthday celebration please contact the President. There is a Cars and Coffee meeting location idea from Kurt Niemeyer at Auto Expo and is being turned over to Fred Zacharias for entry into the Bent Pylon. OVR PCA has received an invitation to attend the autocross events with the Wilderness Trail Region in Virginia on April



grew up in a family where vehicles were a means to an end. The station wagon took Mom, Dad and their 3 sons on multiple trips: with us boys looking out the back window and fighting. Trucks would soon enter the picture as we got older. Adding a camper cap to the back of one gave us room to haul the gear and power to pull a boat. I had two uncles who stepped off that path briefly with one owning a Pontiac GTO and the other showing up with an unusual rear-engine Fiat 850. The GTO went away as soon as kids were discussed, but the Fiat staved for many years accumulating almost 180,000 miles while trekking destinations along the east coast.

Even today, I look at our garage and see multiple vehicles that serve a range of purposes. The dedicated track/race car, Becky's Cayenne, the daily driver that exists to do nothing but slam 20,000 to 30,000 miles on a year on the odometer and of course the truck. They each serve a purpose, they each handle a bit differently, and are each used for specific activities.

I would also guess that if I look around your neighborhood (like ours) there are very few "car people". They each tend to have one or two copies of the prevalent mid-sized SUV's. They only want to get from one point to another, with the least fanfare possible. Once on the road the landscape changes as everyone's own personality and limitations show up in what they drive, whether it's an attorney in a Jaguar SUV or an office worker in their Honda Accord.

variations, but we all bring what we have so we can have as much fun as possible. From the Miata to the GT3 Cup we welcome everyone to spend time on track at Mid-Ohio. A tour of our paddock on any given weekend shows margues as far ranging as McLaren's to Honda's. A guick count of our October weekend and we see that only 63 of the 168 drivers were in Porsche's. Many drivers have learned the hard way that the driver in the low HP car is actually quicker than they are in their 400hp Zephyr GT6. To keep HPDE alive we need to be bringing in new and younger drivers. This means that we will be seeing a true variety within manufacturers and experience levels. In previous years we have had a seemingly endless supply of novice drivers, but that has taken a turn as many teens either do not drive at all or do drive but have no interest in possessing a car. The latter group would purchase a car if it would have no maintenance and could charge or refuel itself. As this group of teens are now approaching that 25-30 years of age it is beginning to be reflected in the small numbers of newer drivers, we see attending our events.

If you've stuck it out this long with my miscellaneous ramblings, please hang in there as I assure you this does have a point. To attract younger and newer drivers we as a DE committee, are beginning to consider an HPDE Scholarship program. The parameters are not set, and we are open to suggestions at this time. This program will be for one or two first time attenders at each of our weekends. Please keep in mind when making suggestions that we do want to attract younger drivers.

The process under consideration is an application that would be An HPDE weekend is much like any neighborhood. There are a lot of submitted to the committee 60 days prior to the event. Each member

of the committee would weigh in on the driver's acceptance into the program. The application would need to be submitted by a member of our region, although the applicant is not required to be a member at the time of the submission. As with most programs, changing, expanding, or eliminating the program will be dependent on its success.

71st Mobil1 12 Hours Of **Sebring**

The 2023 12-hours of Sebring edition has been raced and only the #9 Pfaff Motorsports Porsche 911 GT3 R won its GTD-Pro class, the 101st class win for Porsche in the 71 year history of the race. The highly anticipated GTP contest was up-ended with just 18 minutes left of the

The top class of IMSA - GTP started with 8 entries and the #31 Action Express Racing Cadillac was on the pole. But numerous cars had their times as the GTP and race leaders during the race. With 18 minutes left, the race-leading four GTP cars, nose to tail, caught up to the tail end of the field after a safety car yellow flag period, and the GTP entries started passing the slower cars and racing among themselves. One GTP car went off the track, came back on and a large mishap ensued. Both Porsche Penske 963's were taken out as was the race leading GTP entry. The #31 Cadillac inherited the lead and took the checkered flag. Not what we Porschephiles wanted to see!



OVR's local team, Wright Motorsports, had 2 Porsche 911 GT3 R entries, #16 and #77, both in the GTD class. A BMW M4 GT3 won the class with the #16 1st Phorm sponsored car finishing 6th and the #77 Volt Lighting sponsored entry finishing 8th.

The day before the 12 hour Sebring race, the World Endurance Championship (WEC) 1000 mile endurance race was held. The WEC holds most of its races in Europe and overseas. The top class in the WEC is titled Hypercar which similar to the IMSA GTP class.

The 2 Toyota Grazoo Racing entries led most of the laps and took 1st and 2nd. The pole sitting Ferrari AF Corsa was 3rd and Cadillac Racing was 4th. The WEC Porsche Penske Motorsport 963's were 5th and 6th. In the Grand Touring Endurance class (GTE) Corvette Racing won and the Dempsey Proton Porsche 911 RSR 2nd. The next WEC race is at Portimao, Portugal on April 16.

For those of us who have never been on a track with our P-cars, many may have an interest in understanding how that experience might feel. The Rally/Tour (RT) and the Driver Education (DE)committees have joined forces to provide a combined event, for a select number of drivers.

Our DE team will be conducting an event on the first weekend in June at the Mid Ohio Race Track located in Lexington, Ohio. And the RT team (working with our DE team) is going to piggyback on that event by providing an opportunity for a limited number of drivers, to experience the track, for a single driving session. Here are some particulars.

What are we doing?

The Driver Education Team has agreed to host a limited number of RT drivers with their cars for about 30 minutes of lap time on Saturday afternoon, June 2, 2023. The program will begin with the Official Drivers Education Introduction and is unfortunately limited to just 25 participants, due to instructor availability.

We will be staying at hotels/motels located near the race track, where we will gather for a simple dinner event on Saturday for everyone. Typically, this is something like pizza, so people can meet, greet, socialize and mingle.

Then, bright and early on Sunday morning, June 3, 2023, the Rally/Tour participants will grab some breakfast and meet at a designated location for a driving tour headed South.

Who is invited?

The purpose of the DE INTRO program is to provide PCA Members an opportunity to experience high performance driving on the track, without committing to a full day at a Driver Education event. We do understand that some drivers would like to learn more about the PCA Driver Education program, but are not quite ready to be a full time DE Student. The DE INTRO program allows the driver to bring his/her car to the track and participate in one driving session, just as any other student at the Driver Education event.

Although we can only accommodate 25 cars on the track, others are welcome to attend the Saturday evening activities and the Sunday morning road tour. If you ever wondered about what happens at Mid Ohio, you may want to arrive earlier in the day to observe the cars on the track, as they complete their Driver Education laps.

Where and when is it taking place?

Mid Ohio is located in Lexington, Ohio, which is not too far from Mansfield. It is about a 3 hour ride from Cincinnati, if you travel the expressway, or about 4 hours, if you prefer driving State Routes. People will independently drive to the track on Saturday, June 2, 2023. Although people can arrive as early as they choose, the DE INTRO participants must be present no later than 2:00 PM to complete training and readiness assessments. The Road Tour will take place on Sunday June 3, 2023.

We are exploring the possibility of conducting a training session and potential technical inspection within 30 days of the event. This would be a mandatory session for people who have signed up for the track event.


What happens next?

In April, we will be opening up this spectacular event for registration. We will be sending out an email to announce that registration is OPEN. There will be TWO registrations required. One will be for the DE INTRO program and a different one for the Road Tour. Remember, we only have 25 slots available for the DE INTRO program. Therefore, only the first 25 folks who sign up for the DE INTRO will be secured a spot. We will maintain a "wait list" for anyone signing up after we hit the 25 participant mark. There will be a cost of \$100.00 per participant for the DE INTRO program.

We will also be opening the Road Tour at the same time. We will be able to handle 50 cars for this event. So if you cannot get into the DE INTRO, you may still join us for Road Tour from Lexington, Ohio to Cincinnati, Ohio. As is typically the case, there will be a fee of \$10.00 per car for this excursion.


