Dan Porter was a great friend. Unfortunately, we lost Dan a couple of weeks ago. His unshakable dedication to his wife and children was the laser focus of his life, a man who willingly gave his life to God and in return was blessed with a beautiful family, a thriving business and a myriad of friends who loved him and will miss him terribly.



I've met in my lifetime. When I encountered him he was always around folks who knew him well but what was most striking was those he didn't know he treated as if they were the most important person in the room. You can tell a lot about a man by the way he treats people who can do nothing for him.

I met him for the first time at a gathering of Porsche Club members at Grant Karnes' house, around a table in the side yard in the days when Rallye Porsche Mariemont was a spark in Grant's eye. The topic of course was Porsche and Dan knew Porsche. It didn't matter the type, the year, the track. Dan knew it all and he lit up talking about them, his enthusiasm was infectious. I looked at him and said "how do you have room in your head for all this stuff!" he just kind of laughed and smiled.

We've watched and listened from the sidelines for months about his struggle with Covid that infected him in November. We cheered when he made progress, our hearts sank when things didn't go so well. I marveled at his wife's unceasing trust in God and in her heart Dan was just days away from going home and this chapter of their lives would be closed.

Here are some thoughts and memories of Dan as expressed by past OVR presidents.

The day I met Dan Porter, I was out for a run and as I passed his house he rolled into his driveway in his '89 930 on hard, spent Hoosiers, a few weeks after his last track weekend at Mid Ohio. It didn't take long for us to find the foundation and beginnings of our friendship, especially once he figured out I was the guy with the silver '79 930 he'd seen driving around the village. I was fascinated by Dan's knowledge of Porsches, his enthusiasm for everything around him and his creative design genius. One summer afternoon as he was just getting his company, Magnagrafik, started, we found ourselves up at Ault Park shooting pictures for his new website. Our cars were dressed with a magnetic vinyl turbo script, his first product, displayed along the rocker panels. The pair of 930s were polished to perfection. A wedding party was at the park having their photos taken and it wasn't long before the bride and groom made their way up to the concourse. The entire wedding party surrounded the cars for their photos, the photographer staging the bridesmaids and groomsmen artfully among the turbos. I'll never forget the joy on Dan's face as we looked at the pictures a few days later. He loved the fact that his art brought happiness to others. The pictures were stunning. A couple years later, as we sat having coffee watching the final remnants of the Memorial Day parade in Mariemont, I looked at Dan and said, "This would be a great place for a Porsche car show." Dan's characteristic wry smile spread across his face as he replied, "Heck yeah it would be!!" Several weeks later he brought over a prepress copy of the very first Rallye Porsche Mariemont poster. My jaw hit the ground. I was stupefied at how cool it was. Today, I gaze upon it as I

There was a brief discussion on direct involvement with charitable groups rather than just donating money to them.

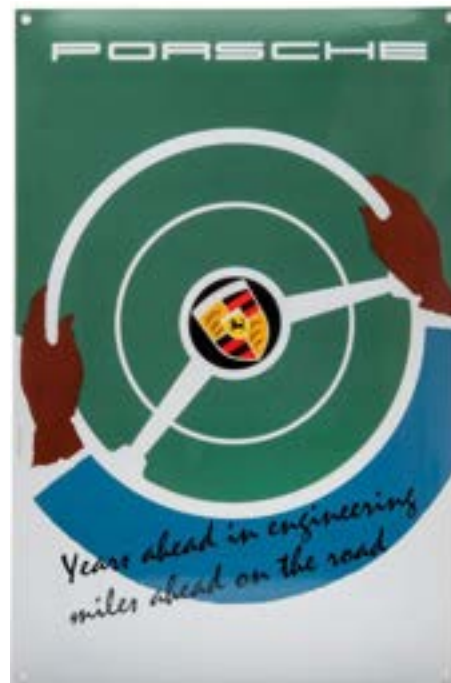
